Sprijinul popular pentru guvernarea globală şi cosmopolitism / The Popular Support for Global Government and Cosmopolitism

Abstract:

A specific process associated with the globalization is the development, among the general public, of the pro-globalist attitudes. This is measured by the public identification with the institutions in the regional and global government, the trust in super-national institutions and the support for the public policies aiming to abolish the national barriers, politics that include those of the free commerce, and the opening of the national market to immigrants. The present paper begins with a review of the concepts of global government in the context of nowadays social and political developments. We will address the theories and explain the popular support to these processes and to the way the research of this phenomenon give answers to the questions about the destiny of the nation-state. A case study on the tendencies in the popular attitude towards the European Parliament will complete this study.
