Strict Implication and Ethical Paradoxes

Abstract:

Starting from the specific of ethical values, the paper emphazises the modalities in which ethical judgements can be formalized in the language of propositions, considering that the rules of detachement from the logic of ethical values are different than those from the logic of truth values. Because the imposing of ethical codes is not logically or epistemologically fundamented, but ideologically, by sustaining the principle of authority against the principles of logic and the principle of tolerance, the paper shows how one can develop a method of decision for implication sentences which allows the demonstration of validity for formulas which contain ethical operators
