Abstract:

The changes in the volume and structure of the Family don't occur the same manner in European and Extra-European societies. The modifications concern the choice of the partner and the structure of the Family, the marital and sexual behavior, the dimensions of the Family, the roles, functions, attitudes and stability in the Family. The decrease of Fertility and Natality particularly, the use of Birth-control and the diminishing of children number in the Family have important Demographic results. The notion of family gets a new meaning, which some of the Western Policies took into consideration. There were emerged new types of Families and types of co-habitations, the increasing of singles, consensual relationships, etc.

We can synthesize the trends which evince nowadays within the Family:

1. The age of women at first marriage is increasing,
