Abstract

Adolescence is considered by a large number of specialists as a critical period for the development of identity and self-concept. The meta-analyses conducted on the topic of differences between sexes in personality stress that the level of male adolescents' self-esteem is higher, even though the difference is small. The paper presents theoretical aspects relevant to sex differences in self-esteem, and analyses the causes of girls' poorer self-image and less confidence in themselves, emphasizing the impact of gender role identification in adolescence.
