II. Modul de organizare și Statutul de funcționare a Centrului de Cercetare.

1. Denumirea, participanții, structura, forma juridică, sediul, durata de activitate

1.1. Denumirea va fi Centrul de Studii asupra Transformărilor Sociale

1.2. Centrul de Studii asupra Transformărilor Sociale este o structură fără personalitate juridică, apolitică, nonprofit, cu profil profesional, științific și educațional.

1.3. Centrul de Studii al Transformărilor Sociale este subordonat Departamentului de Sociologie-Asistență Socială și Filosofie din cadrul facultății de Științe Socio-Umane, Universitatea din Oradea și este constituit pe baza hotărârii Senatului Universității din Oradea HSU 35/25.11.2013 și HCA 38/27.09.2013, obținând Certificatul Nr. 17457/16.12.2013. Centru a avut recunoaștere CNCSIS Certificat nr. 44-CC-B în 02.06.2005, tip C, nr. 125.

1.4. Sediul Centrului de Studii asupra Transformărilor Sociale va fi în cadrul Universității din Oradea, str. Universității, nr. 1, Oradea, 410087, Bihor, Romania – campus 2, clădire V, et. 1.

1.5. Centrul de Studii asupra Transformărilor Sociale se înființează pe perioadă nedeterminată.

2. Scopul și necesitatea constituirii

Obiectivele Centrul de Studii asupra Transformărilor Sociale sunt următoarele:

- Investigarea schimbării sociale, a structurii sociale și a principalelor unități sociale, pe plan local, național și internațional;
- Analiza nevoilor societății și contribuția la elaborarea politicilor sociale care răspund la aceste nevoi;
- Promovarea cercetării în științe sociale și a specialiștilor în sociologie și asistență socială, atât pe ramura academică, cât și cea aplicativă a activităților lor;
- Promovarea cercetării științifice novatoare și de calitate în științe sociale;
- Promovarea relațiilor de colaborare, parteneriat pe proiecte legate de cercetarea sociologică între Universitatea din Oradea și universități, centre, instituții, unități de cercetare similare din țară și străinătate.
- Să acționeze ca forum de atitudine în domeniu vieții sociale și al moralității publice și să propună măsuri de întreprins în aceste domenii;
- Să contribuie la o cultură sociologică a colectivității, dezvoltând capacități de acțiune colectivă.

3. Obiect de activitate

Activitățile principale realizate de Centrul de Studii asupra Transformărilor Sociale pentru atingerea obiectivelor vor fi următoarele:

- Elaborarea și implementarea de proiecte de cercetare și de intervenție în domeniul sociologiei, politicilor sociale, politicilor publice și al asistenței sociale;
- Realizarea de studii în conformitate cu obiectivele Centrului de cercetare;
- Organizarea de training-uri, cursuri de specializare sau școli de vară;
- Organizarea de baze de date, elaborarea publicațiilor, inclusiv pagini web, sau alte materiale pentru diseminarea de informații de cercetare în conformitate cu obiectivele centrului;
- Organizarea de întâlniri (conferințe, mese rotunde etc.) pe teme de interes pentru activitatea Centrului;
- Alte activități în conformitate cu obiectivele Centrului.

4. Principii de organizare și funcționare, Organigrama

4.1. Centrul de Studii asupra Transformărilor Sociale își propune să funcționeze ca o instituție democratică, în care deciziile se iau prin deliberare și prin consens. Orice conflict va fi abordat mai întâi prin discuții și negociere.

4.2. Știința este o întreprindere intelectuală și colegială. Conținutul științific al activității Centrului nu se subordonează arbitrarului deciziilor administrației Centrului, ci normelor de validitate și de etică unanim recunoscute de comunitatea oamenilor de știință.

4.3. Organul de conducere și administrare a centrului de cercetare este Adunarea Generală a membrilor Centrului de Studii asupra Transformărilor Sociale. Adunarea Generală cuprinde toți membrii Centrului de Studii asupra Transformărilor Sociale.

4.4. Adunarea Generală are următoarele atribuții:

- alege membrii Consiliului Director
- votează planul de activități a Centrului.
- dezbate și votează propunerile Consiliului Director, ale membrilor, în cadrul reuniunilor sale.

4.7. Activitățile Centrului de Studii asupra Transformărilor Sociale se implementează în cadrul echipelor de lucru. Acestea se structurează în mod dinamic și sunt constituite pentru inițierea și/sau realizarea unei activități sau acțiuni (program, proiect, curs, contract de cercetare, consultanță etc.). După caz, echipele de lucru pot fi gestionate de către un coordonator, membru în cadrul centrului de cercetare.

4.8. Fiecare coordonator are autonomie în alegerea membrilor echipelor de lucru și stabilirea structurii bugetului corespunzător tipului de activitate a echipei, precum și executarea bugetului alocat, în limita prevăzută în documentele contractuale și în conformitate cu statutul și regulamentul de funcționare al Centrului. Responsabilitatea în ceea ce privește calitatea și rezultatele activității desfășurate revine fiecărei echipe de lucru.

4.9. Conducerea executivă a centrului de cercetare este asigurată de către un *Consiliu Director*, format din 5 membri aleși de către Adunarea Generală.

4.10. Structura *Consiliului Director* este următoarea:

- director general
- director științific
- director relații internaționale
- director programe
- director administrativ

4.11. Membrii Consiliului Director sunt aleși pentru un mandat de 4 ani de către Adunarea Generală a Centrului de Studii asupra Transformărilor Sociale prin majoritate simplă.

4.12. *Consiliul director* are următoarele competențe și atribuții principale:

- administrează fondurile și mijloacele fixe ale centrului de cercetare;
- convoacă reuniunile Adunării Generale a membrilor.
- elaborează Regulamentul Interior de Funcționare a centrului;
- aprobă înființarea echipelor de lucru, componența acestora precum și atribuțiile interne, la propunerea acestora;
- rezolvă problemele curente, reprezentând centrul în relațiile cu terții;
- confirmă primirea de noi membri și propune revocarea membrilor care încalcă prevederile statutului;
- în cazul aprobării unor proiecte de cercetare, stabilește sarcinile;
- propune regulile de etică profesională asociate Centrului.

4.13. Consiliul director se întrunește în ședințe ori de câte ori este nevoie dar cel puțin odată pe semestru pentru rezolvarea problemelor curente ale centrului de cercetare.

4.14. Revocarea unui membru al Consiliului Director se votează, prin majoritate simplă, de către Adunarea Generală, la propunerea a cel puțin 3 membri ai Consiliului Director sau a cel puțin o treime din membrii Centrului atunci când membrul respectiv a încălcat grav acest statut și normele deontologiei profesionale.

4.15. Poate fi membru al centrului orice profesor, cercetător sau student la doctorat sau la un program de masterat din cadrul Universității din Oradea, din domeniile: sociologie și asistență socială sau alte domenii conexe.

4.16. Primirea membrilor se face pe baza unei cereri din care să rezulte clar implicarea în cel puțin o activitate derulată prin Centrul de Studii asupra Transformărilor Sociale, cerere ce se supune aprobării Consiliului Director.

4.17. Drepturile membrilor centrului de cercetare:

- Să aleagă și să fie ales în organele de conducere;
- Să participe la ședințele Adunării Generale, să voteze în cadrul acestora și să facă propuneri în legătură cu activitatea Centrului.
- Să inițieze cercetări și alte acțiuni ce corespund scopului și obiectivelor centrului.

4.18. Obligațiile membrilor centrului de cercetare:

5. Patrimoniul Centrului de Cercetare
